BACHELOR OF ARTS IN MUSIC EDUCATION: INSTRUMENTAL

Completion of this major prepares one to assume the responsibilities of a public school music teacher or a private music instructor. Continued study may include a master's degree in music education or music supervision.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THIS DEGREE TRACK ARE:

- Audition is required to be admitted into the program.
- A minimum cumulative undergraduate grade point average (CGPA) of 3.0 is necessary to do the internship and be certified.
- After completing Math and English requirements, a student needs to take the Praxis Core if a student cannot be exempt from this requirement. If SAT score is 560 or higher for verbal and 540 or higher on math or 23 or higher on ACT, a student is exempt from this requirement. Without the waiver documentation or passing Praxis Core, a student cannot take any education courses, therefore, MDT strongly recommends students to take Praxis Core early in the curriculum to avoid any delays.
- Beginning in Early part of the junior year, a student needs to start documenting 50 hours of clinical experience.
- Content Praxis should be taken prior to the internship requirements.
- Specific General Education Courses are required: WGST 110, BIO 225 and ECE 212
- During the final Clinical Practice, Ed TPA is needed
- The institution maintains articulation agreements with regional community colleges that define transfer credit policy by course. The Music department, however, requires placement exams in performance, harmony, ear training, and keyboard; the placement exams confirm or deny transfer credit in each course and level.
